CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS

Deadline for abstract submissions: Sept. 15, 2017

We invite abstract submissions for this conference. Accepted papers will be grouped into panels that include scholars from both Mexico and the U.S., with special interest in papers in these areas: Outcomes of intervention and support of migrant populations, justice and due process for unaccompanied minors and immigrant families, social emergencies and high priority situations for social work intervention, deportation and forced return, organizational and community support models for migrant families and populations, policy advocacy and development on cross-border issues, strategies regarding return of vulnerable migrants, ethical considerations in work with migrant populations, and new methods for transnational social work emphasizing human rights within complex migratory processes.

Submission guidelines: Each abstract submission should include a title and a summary of 200 to 250 words clearly expressing the primary ideas of the work. Attention should be given to one or more of the areas described above. Implications for policy or social work practice should be delineated. The submission must include: Name(s) of author(s), Institutional Affiliation(s), and email address(es). Abstract submissions should be emailed to [Michelle.Skidmore@utsa.edu](mailto:Michelle.Skidmore@utsa.edu). The review committee will notify authors about acceptance decisions on Sept. 22, 2017. Accepted authors will have until Oct. 18, 2017 to submit full papers for future publication (15 to 30 pages in length).
